**Background to Inspection:**

Following discussions between FLSS & TPC it was arranged that a Technical security inspection of your client's premises be carried out.

The inspection was carried out on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2002. By Christian PW Faust at 8

Hannabus Place, XXXX, NSW. XXXX.

**Summary of Inspection:**

All of the rooms in the designated areas were illuminated acoustically by means of distinctive noise sources.

All nominated telephone sets; extensions and lines were checked electronically from the instruments back to their main distribution frame.

All power wiring in the client's area was checked for the presence of suspicious signals in the very low frequency (VLF) to mid low frequency range.

Pmhe radio spectrum was checked for compromising signals in the mid very high frequency (VHF) to mid ultra high frequency (UHF) range.

**Details of Inspection:**

The purpose of the inspection of the telephone system was to determine whether unauthorised connections or modifications had been made to the lines in that conversations could be overheard remotely when the telephone set was either in use or NOT in use. The electronic test carried out during the inspection revealed that there were NO active informalities.

The mains power wiring was also scanned in order to determine whether low frequency devices were being used to transmit intelligence from the premises via power lines. There were NO indications of such devices operating at the time of the inspection.

The segment of the radio frequency spectrum most commonly used for illegal eavesdropping devices was monitored by the aid of electronic computerised scanning, for evidence of such transmissions. There was an indication of an abnormality having previously existed, however the cause could be related to interference from the satellite dish. There were NO other indications of any devices operating at the time of the inspection.

**Conclusion:**

No abnormalities were indicative at the time of inspection.
